MESSAGE FROM ACTORS THEATRE


Thank you for joining us for Lobster Feast 2011—*POP Goes the Sixties!*

LIVE AND SILENT AUCTION RULES

1. Each item in the silent auctions has a bid sheet with it on the auction table. Persons desiring to bid may do so by writing in their bid number (given to you at registration and on the back of your catalog) and the amount bid on the bid sheet. **Use only the bid number assigned to you.**
2. Each new bid must be written on the next blank line available on the bid sheet. **Bids will be disqualified if the minimum raise is not sufficient.**
3. The Silent Section I: *POP! Collection* will be open for bidding from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The Silent Auction Section II: *Fantasy Collection* will be open from 6:30 p.m. to 10:15 p.m. Closing times are listed in the catalog and will be announced throughout the evening. Only an authorized official may nullify a bid, and the closing bid circled by the official constitutes a winning bid.
4. In the event of a dispute, the auction official shall act as the final authority and shall determine the winning bidder. In the event that two bidders are in the process of bidding on the same item when the official attempts to circle the winning bid, the official may conduct a mini live auction between those two bidders. The official shall determine the winning bidder and his/her decision shall be final.
5. Bidders can determine if they have winning bids by checking the bid sheet 15 minutes after the auction closes at check out. The winning bidder will check out and pay the cashier. The cashier will be open at 9:00 p.m.
6. Use your catalog as your bid paddle for the **live auction**.
7. Any winning bidder not making arrangements for payment on the night of the auction may forfeit his/her right to purchase the item.
8. Unless otherwise specified, **auction items and services must be used within one year from the date of the auction.** Unless otherwise specified, dates and time are to be arranged at the mutual convenience of and by and between the donor and buyer. To avoid disappointment, please make all vacation reservations well in advance. Security and cleaning deposits, when required by the donor, must be paid directly to the donor and are not included in your bid.
