Under the leadership of Artistic Director Les Waters and Managing Director Kevin E. Moore, Actors Theatre serves to unlock human potential, build community and enrich quality of life by engaging people in theatre that reflects the wonder and complexity of our time.

Actors Theatre presents almost 350 performances annually across three theatres and delivers a broad range of programming impacting local and national audiences with a particular focus on new play development influencing the field of American theatre. Programs include classical repertory and contemporary work through the Brown-Forman Series, holiday favorites cherished as annual traditions, the Humana Festival of New American Plays influencing the canon of American theatre, an Education program where students see and make plays, and a theatre training program for 40+, the Professional Training Company.

**Summary of Position:**

The Scenic Carpenter constructs scenery and set pieces in accordance with designer plans; including carpentry, welding, work with plastics, fabrics or other materials.

The Essential Functions includes, but are not limited to the following:

**Essential Functions:**

- Constructs, transports, sets up, and strike all set pieces.
- Enforces daily shop cleanup and organization.
- Installs scenery on stage including mechanically moving pieces, stationary pieces and flying pieces.
- Prepares area around stage; could include special railings, seat installation or removal or painting vomms and tiers.

- Assists other departments in moving large equipment or heavy material handling.
- Assists other departments as time and production needs demand.
- Carry out other duties and responsibilities that may be assigned by direct supervisor or management.

**Knowledge, Skills, Abilities:**

- Broad knowledge of carpentry, metal working, rigging, tools and theatrical products.
- Ability to understand and execute construction drawings.
- Ability to work as a team member and maintain a positive attitude in times of stress.
- Ability to lift, carry, push, pull or otherwise maneuver up to 70 lbs repeatedly, either alone or with assistance.
- Ability to work on ladders, mechanical lifts or other high places.
- Ability to work confined spaces.
- Ability to work independently and be self-motivated.
- Ability to work with grace under pressure of multiple deadlines.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Undergraduate degree in technical theatre or professional equivalent.
- Work a flexible schedule, including evenings and weekends.

**Preferred Qualifications:**

- Two (2) years professional experience.
- Familiarity with AutoCAD.
